Course Outline GLE4OI and GLE3OI Advanced Learning Strategies: Skills for Success After Secondary School,

This course focuses on learning strategies to help students become better, more independent learners. Students will learn how to develop and apply literacy, numeracy skills, personal management skills and interpersonal and teamwork skills to improve learning and achievement in school, the workplace and the community. The course helps students build confidence and motivation to pursue opportunities for success in secondary school and beyond.

Learning Skills

 Identify and analyse personal learning styles in order to identify and overcome academic and personal barriers (low self-esteem, anxiety, test taking, essay)

Personal Management

- Compare and evaluate personal management skills to identify the areas in need of improvement.
- Adapt study techniques and test taking strategies to different subjects and test formats.

Exploration of Opportunities

- Research workplace trends (contract work, telecommuting), and the use of technology in the workplace.
- Identify resources available to support learning, daily living, and transition to post-secondary opportunities (library, internet, tutors, and community agencies).

Preparation for Transitions and Change

- Develop a resume and cover letter and maintain an updated portfolio.
- Demonstrate the ability to conduct themselves effectively in an interview.
- Demonstrate the use of interpersonal skills that contribute to achieving goals (communicating with employers, applying for a job).
